We will soon send out our class lists. Some students will be changing classrooms, and some will not. Sometimes, when a child is not changing rooms, the question is asked: Does that mean they are being held back? <u>This is not the case, as each child works at their level</u>. There is no repeating of a level or set curriculum for a Year Group. In each class, there are ability groups regardless of their year level. Students are grouped based on their needs in particular areas. Groups often change throughout the day in a class as they move from subject to subject. We are continually assessing the needs of the students and adjusting groups as necessary. You will see a mixture of genders and year levels within class groups. This grouping process is called differentiated learning. Differentiated learning means learning at different levels based on the needs of the learners. There is no set curriculum for a year level. It is all about needs-based teaching.

Consequently, the students set goals to work towards the New Zealand Curriculum Achievement Levels. The first step in goal-setting will be at the start of the year in our 3-way conferences.

Next year, we will start the year with 3-Way-Conferences on Tuesday, the 30th of January, 2024. Classes will begin on Wednesday, the 31st of January, 2024. Information on how to book your 3-Way Conference will come out with the class lists.

If you cannot do this, please call the office, and we can book it for you.







# MT HUTT 2024 PASSES

Off the back of another great winter, we're excited to offer the Mt Hutt Local Schools Season Pass again for 2024!

As in previous years, the Local Schools Season Pass offers access to all NZSki mountains, including Coronet Peak, The Remarkables and Mt Hutt for the duration of the 2024 winter season.

Age permutations for adults remain at 16 years and up for our standard products. However, for local schools we are continuing to offer child rates to students who be aged 16-18 years of age as of the 1<sup>st</sup> of June 2024 if they are still in attendance at an eligible local school. The Local School Pass will be available to purchase until **Friday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2024**, after which point, the pass will not be available to purchase.

As per, upon the close of sale for the Local School Season Pass, we will be in touch with each school to confirm that the students we have noted as attending your school are registered with you. We very much appreciate your help and support on this to ensure that we can continue to provide discounted rate passes to local students.

Pricing for 2024 remains the same as in 2023 and is \$139 for the Primary School Pass and \$219 for the Secondary School Pass. To purchase, you can find the online links below.



## NEW LIBRARY OPENS 8.30am, Monday 22 January

#### Why are you closing?

The three-week closure will allow us to move over 60,000 books (and other items) to the new building. Make sure you come and stock up on books before we close the doors on 31 December!

#### How can I access the internet or printing services?

Wi-Fi will still be available during the closure at the old library building. You will need to be parked or seated nearby to connect. Printing and scanning can be done at Warehouse Stationery or PaperPlus.

#### Where can I return my books?

Books issued before the closure will not be due back until we open in the new building. You'll still be able to return books to us at any time via the return slot at the entrance of the old library building.
